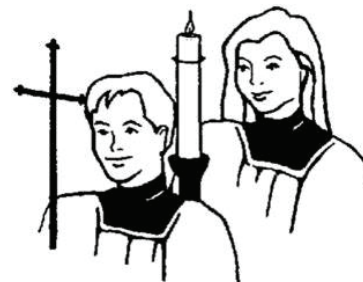


HEALING & RECONCILIATION COLLECTION
