The "anchor" pictured on the front of our parish bulletin is connected to the martyrdom of our patron, Saint Clement, third Pope after St. Peter. Clement was arrested and sent by the Roman authorities to work at hard labour in the mines. He died at sea. Tradition tells us that Clement was tied to a ship's anchor and thrown over the side of a boat.

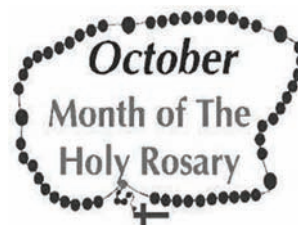
