VISIT THE CHAPEL – PRAY FOR THE SOULS IN PURGATORY

On All Souls' Day, and throughout the month of November, Catholics are encouraged to pray for the Souls in Purgatory. Special indulgences may be gained



indulgences may be gained for those we love and remember. Drop into the St. Clement Adoration Chapel once a day, every day, and pray for the Faithful Departed. May they rest in peace. Amen!

WHAT IS PURGATORY?

According to the Catechism of the Catholic Church, Purgatory is the state of those who die in God's friendship, assured of their eternal salvation, but who still have need of purification to enter into the happiness of heaven (CCC 210). Popular piety often speaks of Purgatory as a physical place, a place of fire, but those elements are not part of the Church's doctrine. Purgatory is the saving embrace of God's purifying love which prepares us for the glory of Heaven.

WHAT IS AN INDULGENCE?

Indulgences are the remission before God of temporal punishment due to sins whose guilt has already been forgiven. The faithful Christian who is duly disposed gains the indulgence under prescribed conditions for either himself or the departed. Indulgences are granted through the ministry of the Church which, as the dispenser of the grace of redemption, distributes the treasury of the merits of Christ and the Saints (CCC312).

ALL SOULS' DAY INDULGENCE

On All Souls' Day a plenary indulgence, applicable only to the Souls in Purgatory, is granted to the faithful who devoutly visit a cemetery and pray for the departed. The same plenary indulgence is granted to those who piously visit a church. During such a visit, it is required that one Our Father and the Creed be recited.

CONDITIONS FOR A PLENARY INDULGENCE

A Plenary Indulgence is remission of the entire temporal punishment for sin. To acquire a plenary indulgence, it is necessary also to fulfill the following three conditions: sacramental Confession, Eucharistic communion, and prayer for the intention of the Holy Father (Our Father & Hail Mary) while being detached from sin. It is sufficient that these sacred rites and prayers be carried out within several days before or after the indulgenced act.

FIRST FRIDAY

November 4th is First Friday. Devotion prayers in honour

of the Sacred Heart of Jesus will be prayed ten minutes before the 8:15 morning Mass. A period of adoration of the Blessed Sacrament will follow Mass and end



with Benediction at 10:00 a.m.

Most Sacred Heart of Jesus. Have mercy on us!

FIRST SATURDAY

November 5th is First Saturday. This devotion is a request made by Our Lady to Sister Lucia of Fatima. The Blessed Mother



promised to assist at the hour of death, those who keep the First Saturdays for five consecutive months. We are asked to:

1. Go to confession within the week; 2. Receive Holy Communion on the Saturday; 3. Say five decades of the rosary; 4. Keep Mary company for fifteen minutes meditating on the mysteries of the rosary.

STANDARD TIME BEGINS



Keep in mind that Standard Time begins next **Sunday, November 6th.** Turn your clock back one full hour. And don't be late for Mass!
