

CHURCH TERMINOLOGY

The **NARTHEX** is the vestibule or lobby area just inside the front doors of the church. The **NAVE** is the main seating area, and the **SANCTUARY** is the raised area at the front of the church. A **CHAPEL** is a room separated from the main church and reserved for private prayer or for adoration of the Blessed Sacrament.

WHAT'S A CHANCERY OFFICE?

The "chancery" is the official name for the administrative offices of the Archdiocese of Toronto. It's situated on the upper floors of the Catholic Pastoral Centre at Yonge and Summerhill. The Chancery houses the office of His Eminence Thomas Cardinal Collins, as well as offices for his two formal delegates, the Chancellor for Spiritual Affairs and the Chancellor for Temporal affairs. The Catholic Pastoral Centre is also home to a variety of departments which serve the needs of the Archdiocese. For example, the Marriage Tribunal, Human Resources, Planning & Properties, Clergy Personnel and Chaplaincy, Share Life, etc.



CATHOLIC FUNERAL PRACTICE

A Catholic funeral normally includes three steps or stages. First, vigil prayers at the funeral home. Second, a Funeral Mass in the church. And third, burial or entombment of the body, or of cremated remains. If cremation is chosen, this may take place before or after the funeral Mass.

VOTIVE CANDLES

Burning "votive candles" is a common practice in most Catholic parishes. Here at St. Clement, we have candle racks at Our Lady's Shrine and at the Shrine of St. Peregrine. The word "votive" comes from the Latin votum, meaning a "promise or a prayer". The candles we light are visible signs of the prayers we lift up to God.
