

Clement Parish. Next: Our Lady of Sorrows Church – St. Gregory Church – Nativity Church – and the final decade at St. Clement. For more information visit



#### **INDIGENOUS HEALING & RECONCILIATION COLLECTION**




Catholics throughout the Archdiocese of Toronto are invited to participate in the collection to support indigenous healing and reconciliation. Next

commitment to the Gospel. How do we best express the love of Jesus Christ for these struggling brothers and sisters?


