

GAUDETE SUNDAY



The *Third Sunday of Advent* is traditionally called *Gaudete* (*gow-day-tay*) *Sunday*. This Latin word is an invitation to rejoice. We give thanks because the birthday of our Saviour is near. The celebrant of the Mass wears *rose coloured vestments* as a sign of our joy, and we light the *rose candle* on our Advent Wreath.

well-known hymn, "O Come, Emmanuel" is based on these acclamations and fittingly used at Mass on the final Sundays of Advent.

The first few weeks of Advent direct our attention to the second coming of Christ. But the Advent weekdays from **December 17th to December 24th** are intended as a direct preparation for Christmas.
