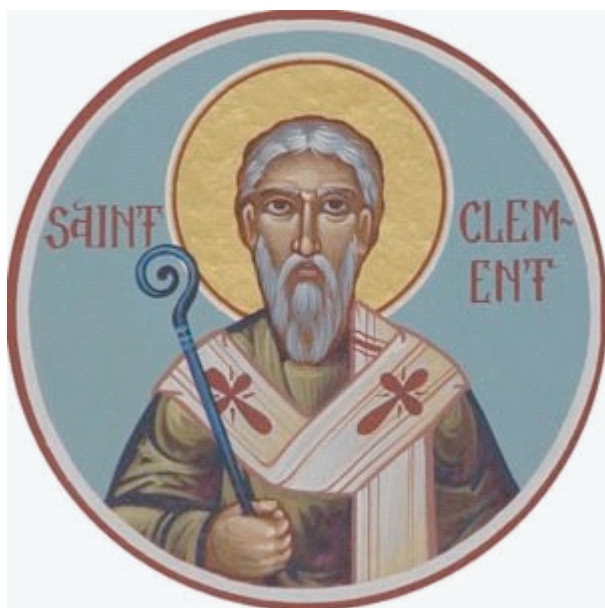

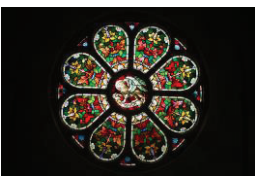

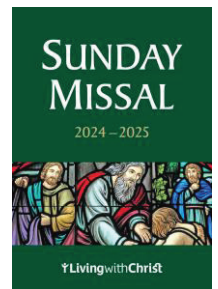
In his message for this weekend's World Day of the Poor Pope Francis says:

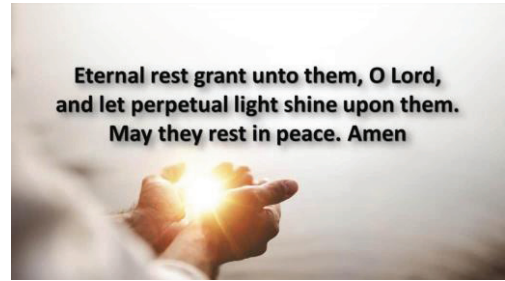
