

SUGGESTIONS FOR CELEBRATING ADVENT 2024

Advent is a season of joyful preparation for the coming of Christ, with true joy the knowledge that loving God will clear away all the obstacles we ourselves have made to his coming into our lives in full. We begin therefore in a spirit of repentance as we "await with joyful hope the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ". In that spirit, I offer the following as suggestions for celebrating Advent 2024:

PRAY daily using the Sunday or Weekday Advent Mass Readings

VISIT OUR ADORATION CHAPEL - Open Monday to Friday 7 a.m. to Noon for a quiet time of prayer in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament

ATTEND WEEKDAY MASS during this season - the powerful symbolism of the readings and prayers will be a peaceful reprieve from this busy season.

COME TO FIRST FRIDAY MASS AND HOLY HOUR ON

DECEMBER 6 - Mass at 8:15 a.m. followed by a Holy Hour in the Church from 8:45 a.m. to 9:45 a.m.

INVITE A FRIEND, loved one or neighbour to join you for Sunday mass in Advent

SUPPORT THOSE IN NEED through your support of the St. Vincent de Paul Christmas Collection (which funds the good works of the Society at Christmas and throughout 2025). Extra envelopes are available at the doors of the church and can be dropped into

the Sunday offertory basket or dropped off at the parish office. Cheques payable please to SVDP Society- St. Clement and please fill in the information on the donation envelope to receive a tax receipt. VISIT THE LONELY, the sick, those who mourn perhaps inviting one of them to join your family for Christmas mass or dinner this year.

BE RECONCILED TO GOD and one another through the healing Sacrament of Reconciliation (Confession) before Christmas. Advent has been called a "smaller Lent," and is as important a season as the one leading up to the Resurrection. This Sacrament of Reconciliation is available as follows:

THE ADVENT WREATH

The Advent Wreath is a focus for prayer during the four weeks leading up to Christmas. It marks the steps in our Advent journey. The wreath is a circle of evergreen branches with



four candles, three purple and one rose (pink), one for each of the Sundays of Advent.

ADVENT WREATH BLESSING

God of hope and love, we praise you for sending Jesus, your Son, to save us from our sins and to be the light in our darkness. Bless us as we gather in his name, and bless this wreath as a sign of your unending love and of Jesus' presence among us. Keep us watchful in prayer as we await his return in glory. We ask this through Jesus Christ our Lord,

who lives with you and the Holy Spirit, in eternal glory, God for ever and ever. Amen.
