

During Lent there are no flowers in the church, the Gloria is not sung at Sunday Mass, purple vestments are used, and the sound of the Alleluia disappears until Easter. This year we will also refrain from using incense at our Sunday11:30 am Mass during Lent.

We will also begin the practice of remaining SEATED for the

Offertory Procession at each weekend mass. We have already stood for the Entrance Procession and Gospel and there is no need to repeat this posture for the Offertory Procession. We remain seated until the priest arrives at the altar and invites us to pray. This is consistent with the practice of other parishes in the Archdiocese of Toronto.
