

Co-Op preacher Fr. Rubens Sylvain (see below), and from Tuesday July 22 to Thursday July 31 we welcome Fr. Charles Egbulefu, C.C.E. back to St. Clement Parish to cover the weekday and weekend Masses. Thank you, Fr. Rubens and Fr. Charles!

MISSIONARY CO-OP 2025: Scalabrini Mission to Haiti

On the weekend of July 19/20, we will welcome Scalabrini priest Fr. Rubens Sylvain to speak about the work of the Mission of St. Thomas the Apostle in Haiti. Motivated by the philosophy and lifestyle of their



founder, St. John Baptist Scalabrini, with his famous statement "*the Church must be where the people suffer and struggle,*" the Scalabrinian missionaries came to Haiti to train new missionaries to serve migrants, refugees, and displaced persons around the world. With the devastating earthquake of January 12, 2010, the need to accompany internal migrants by opening a mission became apparent. Now the community has: the *Seminary* for the formation of new Scalabrinian religious, the *Holy Spirit Clinic*, which offers daily healing services to more than 150 patients and preventive services each week to about 400 people, including pregnant women, etc., the *Beniamino Center*, which offers a space for fun and formation for all, the *San Carlos Borromeo Mixed School* for the education of new citizens with Christian and human values (more than 500 students), and *Saint Thomas the Apostle Mission* to bring people closer to the Lord's flock.

All this is done with the support of generous people who have a sense of togetherness, since the context does not allow for the self-sustainability of the works.

Founded in Poland in 1855, the Felician Sisters are a congregation of women religious inspired by the spiritual ideals of their foundress, Blessed Mary Angela Truszkowska. Following Blessed Mary Angela's directive *"to serve where needed,"* they helped to weave the social service system.

Today, the Felician Sisters have founded, sponsored or supported, through the presence of our sisters, more than 40 ministries – all continuing to evolve to meet the needs of the people they serve, through parts of the US and Canada. **Congratulations Sisters!**

SUMMER RENOVATION PROJECTS

Rectory Kitchen, Bathroom and Bedroom Renovations: We have moved ahead with a planned major renovation of the rectory kitchen and bathrooms, replacing flooring, cabinetry and fixtures that have been in place since the house was built in 1969, and removing a wall between the kitchen and living area. We are also insulating the walls of two of the bedrooms facing north and east. At present I have migrated to the basement until the project is complete in mid-August. This project will be paid for by our Funds on Deposit with the Archdiocese of Toronto. Parish Hall: We are installing a ceiling mounted projector and fixed retractable screen, along with capacity for laptop and DVD presentations, as well as speakers and microphones (wired and wireless) and also an upgrade of hall electrical outlets and new outlets as needed. This project will be completed in August and will be paid for through Maintenance Collection funds.
