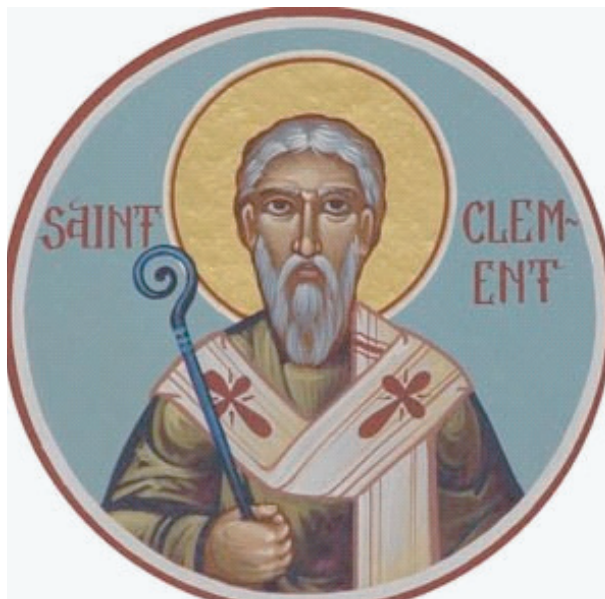

As one of many valued residents who live with dementia, his cognitive impairment can leave him feeling vulnerable and confused.

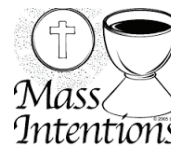
Your compassion makes it possible for him to be surrounded by both his family and caregivers in a comforting environment.

SUMMER RENOVATION PROJECTS

Rectory Kitchen, Bathroom and Bedroom Renovations:

We have moved ahead with a planned major



renovation of the rectory kitchen and bathrooms, replacing flooring, cabinetry and fixtures that have been in place since the house was built in 1969, and removing a wall

between the kitchen and living area.

We are also insulating the walls of two of the bedrooms facing north and east. At present I have migrated to the basement until the project is complete in mid-August.

This project will be paid for by our Funds on Deposit with the Archdiocese of Toronto.

Parish Hall: We are installing a ceiling mounted projector and fixed retractable screen, along with capacity for laptop and DVD presentations, as well as speakers and microphones (wired and wireless) and also an upgrade of hall electrical outlets and new outlets as needed.

This project will be completed in August and will be paid for through Maintenance Collection funds.

TIP TAP PAY FOR OFFERTORY

The Archdiocese of Toronto has partnered with Tip Tap Pay so that you can help support your parish with a simple tap of your debit or credit card.

We have installed a Tip Tap Pay stand in the main foyer of the church: simply tap the 'tip tap' device in the front foyer of the church to make an offertory gift to the parish. That's it!

You can also receive a tax receipt for your 'tip tap' gift as well. After your first tap, scan the parish QR Code with your smart phone and register your payment card. After your card has been registered, you will receive an end-of-year tax receipt for all your 'tip tap' gifts. No more worrying about having cash or writing a cheque-just tap!
