Donations can be dropped off at the container in the parking lot on Saturday between 4 and 6 p.m. and Sunday from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. When donating men's clothing, please place them in a separate labelled bag, they will be donated to the Toronto South Detention Centre. Thank you for your generosity and support.
- **WORLD MISSION SUNDAY** There will be a collection this weekend for the Evangelization of the Nations, otherwise known as World Mission Sunday. This is a worldwide collection for the missionary church, and it is our opportunity to assist at-need Catholic Communities globally. Offerings are combined with offerings from other Catholics around the world and distributed to missions and dioceses. We are called to share from our abundance with those less fortunate who lack the basic essentials to know, love and praise God. Thank you for your support of this important work.

On Friday December 12 we will gather for an *Advent Parish Dinner/Evening of Reflection* with guest speaker Sr. Bernice from Mother Teresa's Missionaries of Charity giving an after-dinner talk on how to live out the Jubilee theme of Hope in our lives. Please mark the date in your calendar and plan to attend!

Finally, just a reminder that we have two *Jubilee Pilgrim Churches in our Western Pastoral Region: Our Lady of Sorrows, Etobicoke and St. Mary's Brampton*.

The Jubilee Plenary Indulgence may be obtained by receiving Holy Communion at any Mass celebrated at a designated pilgrim church in the Archdiocese until the close of the Jubilee year on Sunday December 28, 2025.

The person must also go to confession (within several days before or after the Mass) and pray for the intentions of the Pope (specifically praying 1 Our Father and 1 Hail Mary).
