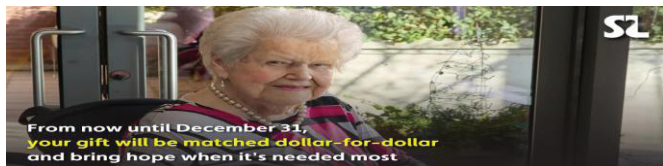
SUNDAY MISSALS 2026
