FROM THE DESK OF FR. TIM...



Today we conclude the Christmas season with the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord. As Blessed Columba Marmion wrote about today's feast:

The mystery of the baptism of Jesus, which marks the beginning of his public life, contains, as it were, the summary of his whole mission here below. By the humiliation which he willed to undergo in receiving this rite of penance "for the remission of sins"—presage of his baptism of

blood upon the Cross—Christ fulfills all justice.

Baptism, with faith in Jesus Christ, has become for us the sacrament of divine adoption and Christian initiation. It is the Name of the Holy Trinity that is conferred upon us, the Trinity that was revealed to us upon the banks of the Jordan....

In the same way as baptism constituted for Christ the summary of all his mission, at once redeeming and sanctifying—so baptism contains for us in germ the whole development of the Christian life with its twofold aspect of "death to sin" and of "life unto God".



Let us who have been baptized in him, listen to the voice that calls us beloved children and gives us work to do, the work of the Gospel proclaimed and lived in love for God and neighbour.



ST. CARLO ACUTIS RELIC AND HALL EXHIBIT: JANUARY 24/25 WEEKEND



Carlo Acutis (3 May 1991 – 12 October 2006) was an English-born Italian Catholic teenager known for his devotion to the Eucharist and his use of digital media to promote Catholic devotion.

Carlo Acutis was canonized as a saint on September 7, 2025, and is referred to as the "*patron saint of the Internet*", "*God's Influencer*" and the "*first millennial saint*".

The Knights of Columbus have arranged a display of the Eucharistic Miracles of the World exhibit in the parish hall on the weekend of **January 24/25**, a creation of Acutis during his life. A reflection of the young man's deep love of the Eucharist, the display features a series of vivid panels, each narrating unique miracles from across centuries and parts of the world. The display will also be present for **Edge Youth Ministry's Friday, January 23rd meeting**.

"The exhibit not only aims to increase awareness in the Real Presence of our Lord in the Eucharist and promote Eucharistic Adoration, but it gives us hope that sainthood is available to each one of us". "Acutis created the exhibit because he wanted to bring people to the Eucharist — he did, and is still doing it from Heaven.

We will also have a first-class relic of St. Carlo Acutis available for veneration that weekend in the Adoration Chapel. St. Carlo Acutis, pray for our young people and for all of us!
