Confession/ Sacrament of Reconciliation during Holy Week

In preparation for the renewal of our baptismal promises at Easter, you are welcome to celebrate the sacrament on the following dates:

Saturday March 28th: 9:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m.,

Tuesday March 31st: 7:30 p.m. to 9:00 p.m.
(after 7 p.m. Mass)

Wednesday April 1st between 7:00 p.m. and 8:30 p.m.
(2 priests available each time).

EASTER TRIDUUM

More and more Catholics are re-discovering the richness of experiencing the Easter Triduum in its three parts – Holy Thursday Mass of the Lord's Supper 7 p.m., Good Friday Services 11 a.m. (Children's Celebration of the Passion) or 3 p.m. or Stations of the Cross 7 p.m., and the Easter Vigil on Saturday April 4 at 8 p.m. **OR** Easter Sunday Mass at either 9:30 a.m. or 11:30 a.m. I invite you to make these three celebrations your priority in Holy Week 2026.

Holy Thursday Mass and Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament

Immediately following the Mass of the Lord's Supper at 7:00 p.m. there will be a formal procession of the Blessed Sacrament to the Holy Thursday Adoration Chapel downstairs in the Main Hall (new this year). You are encouraged to remain to pray and meditate on the last hours of Jesus life and the suffering he endured for our sakes.

Please join us for an hour or even just a few moments. Adoration concludes at 10 p.m.

Good Friday- Celebration of the Lord's Passion

Please join us for our Good Friday services at 11 a.m. (Children's Celebration of the Passion) or 3 p.m. There will be an opportunity for individual veneration of the cross at the end of each celebration, either directly by kissing the cross, or by touching the cross, or bowing before it as you come up in procession. On Good Friday at 7:00 p.m. you are also invited to join us for the Stations of the Cross. Confession will not be available following the Stations of the Cross.

Flowers for Easter - Holy Saturday 9:00 a.m. to Noon

Thank you for remembering your loved ones at Easter through the bringing of potted flowers of any description to the church on Holy Saturday morning, where they will be placed in our sanctuary for the Easter celebrations.

Every Life is Precious – Protect Mental Health and Support Bill C-218 - Write your Member of Parliament Today! Visit HelpNotHarmCanada.ca

As announced two weekends ago, you are invited to visit *HelpNotHarmCanada.ca* to quickly and respectfully contact your federal Member of Parliament, urging them to support Bill C-218 (The Right to Recover Act). This legislation would amend the Criminal Code to ensure that Medical Assistance in Dying (MAiD) is not extended to individuals whose sole underlying condition is mental illness. Without this amendment, MAiD will be available for mental illness alone beginning in March 2027. A vote is expected to take place mid-April 2026.
