### SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION AND MINISTRIES COORDINATOR

**PILGRIMAGE TO OUR LADY OF GUADALUPE  
SHRINE WITH DEACON MILAN**

Everyone is invited to join a special pilgrimage to the Miraculous Image of Our Lady of Guadalupe in Mexico from **November 9 to 16, 2026**.

In addition to visiting the Basilica of Our Lady of Guadalupe, this pilgrimage will include stops at the tomb of St. Miguel Pro, the Convent of the Holy Cross, San Miguel de Allende, the Sanctuary of Atotonilco, and the Templo de Santa Rosa de Viterbo in the city of Querétaro. We will also visit Christ the King Mountain, where a 75-foot-high statue—similar to the one in Rio de Janeiro—stands atop a 1,000-meter-high mountain. Also added is a one-day trip to San Miguel del Milagro where St. Michael Archangel appeared in 1631 and gave them miraculous water to heal the people ravaged by a plague and Our Lady of Ocotlan where the Statue of the Blessed Mother was found inside of the burning tree in the year 1541.

In Mexico City, pilgrims will have the opportunity to pass through two Holy Doors and receive indulgences.
