Dear Parents/Guardians,

As the pastor of St. Clement Church, I am writing to you today about the Sacraments of Reconciliation (First Confession) and Eucharist (First Communion) which will both be offered to your son/daughter in Grade 2. Please know that the parish is happy to offer whatever assistance we can to you as parents and families- the primary educators of your children in the faith, in this important and joyful time of preparation.

We invite and strongly encourage you and your family to attend either the Saturday evening 4:45 p.m. Mass or Sunday 9:30 a.m. or 11:30 a.m. Masses, especially this year as your child is preparing for the Sacraments of Reconciliation and Eucharist. We also ask that you register with us in the parish if your family has not yet done so. Please visit our webpage <https://stclementset.archtoronto.org/> for our complete Mass schedule and updates.

An integral part of the student's preparation is a home program (with parental assistance) through the completion of two catechetical books entitled "We Prepare for Reconciliation" (for First Reconciliation), and "We Share in the Eucharist" (for First Eucharist). The Registration fee of \$100 per child covers the cost of both these resource books, as well as other books and materials that our **new Sacramental Preparation Coordinator Mrs. Jennifer Van de Coevering** and her catechetical team will be giving to your children during this program of preparation. While the parish (through the meetings in the attached schedule) and school (through our Grade 2 teachers and the religious education curriculum taught by our Catholic schools) will support you in the instruction of the sacraments, your participation at home in working through these catechetical books with your child is a critical element of their preparation.

The First Reconciliation and First Communion preparation schedule is as follows:

We ask that the child and one parent attend the meeting. You will need to provide:

1. Your completed Registration Form (see attached...please print and complete and bring to meeting)
2. A copy of your child's baptismal certificate (even if they were baptized at St. Clement Parish)
3. \$100 materials fee (cash or cheque please)

 - Attendance at each Wednesday 7 p.m. class - see schedule
 - Visits to Grade 2 classrooms at St. Clement School

Wednesday November 18 at 7 p.m. Attendance is mandatory.
4. **2026 FIRST RECONCILIATION CELEBRATION (child and ONE parent)**
Saturday November 21, 2026 10 a.m. - 11 a.m.
OR Wednesday November 25, 2026 7 p.m. - 8 p.m.
(Reservation of specific dates to be done by email in early November)
5. **Enrollment for First Holy Communion:**
Saturday January 23, 2027: 4:45 p.m. Mass
OR Sunday January 24, 2027 at 9:30 a.m. OR Sunday January 24 11:30 a.m. Mass
6. **Preparation for First Holy Communion (February - April 2027)**
 - completion of "We Share in the Eucharist" book at home
 - Attendance at each Wednesday 7 p.m. class - see schedule
 - Visits to Grade 2 classrooms at St. Clement School
7. **First Communion Parent and Child Rehearsal (in the church):**
Wednesday April 21 at 7 pm. Attendance is mandatory.
8. **2027 FIRST COMMUNION MASSES**
Saturday April 24 4:45 p.m. OR Sunday April 25 9:30 a.m. OR Sunday April 25 11:30a.m.
(Reservation of specific dates to be done by email in early March)

As parents, teachers, and priests our task is to work together in helping these little ones appreciate and celebrate God's loving mercy through reception of the Sacrament of Reconciliation, and communion in Christ Jesus through the Sacrament of the Eucharist.
